
- A. APPLICANT must be African American and a United States citizen.

- E. APPLICANT must major in one of the required Business related majors. (Advertising, Marketing, Business, Finance, Accounting, Engineering/ Electrical/Industrial, Math and Computer Science/Information Technology)
- F. APPLICANT must provide proof of enrollment before actual allocation of the awarded funds.
- G. Total Family Income of Applicant must be \$75,000 per year or less.
- H. The application must be postmarked by Friday, April 29, 2011.
- I. SCHOLARSHIP AWARD RECIPIENT MUST AGREE TO ATTEND CITE-VA'S ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP EVENT WHICH WILL BE HELD Saturday, June 11, 2011 at Verizon Communications located at 3013 Hungary Spring, Richmond, Virginia.


