1. Purpose: Through this scholarship, The McComas Chapter of the United Daughters of the Confederacy honors Dr. William Wirt McComas, a Giles County Physician, who was also a Civil War participant, killed in action. The scholarship also honors former beloved chapter members, Georgia Walker Kirk and Maxine Fanning, whose families bequeathed monetary donations, in their honor. Mary Ann Miller chose to contribute to this scholarship, in honor of her mother, who was a nurse.
2. Eligibility: The scholarship is open to any Giles or Narrows High School senior pursuing a nursing education, either through a university, community college, hospital or through The Giles County Technology Center. This scholarship is not based on financial need.
3. Scholarship Value: \$500.00
4. Application: Any eligible, interested applicant should submit an application to The McComas Chapter of The UDC by the deadline of April 15 of the year of the application. A copy of the applicant's high school transcript should be submitted with the application.
5. Selection: The McComas Chapter of the UDC Scholarship Committee will review all applications and select the most deserving applicant. This decision will be final.
6. Presentation: The scholarship award will be presented at the appropriate school's end-of-school awards ceremony. The scholarship money will be provided after one successful term of study, (quarter or semester). After completion of the term, a copy of the school or college grades are to be sent to the treasurer of McComas Chapter UDC.
